Independent Bank breaks ground on new corporate headquarters at the McKinney Corporate Center Craig Ranch

Independent Bank to create up to 400 new jobs during the next five years

McKINNEY, Texas (Jan. 17, 2018) – The McKinney Economic Development Corporation (MEDC) announced McKinney-based Independent Bank held a groundbreaking ceremony today to begin construction on its new corporate headquarters at the McKinney Corporate Center Craig Ranch, bringing up to 400 new jobs to the city during the next five years.

MEDC offered an incentive based on 221 retained jobs, up to 200 new jobs, and for estimated capital expenditure of \$52,000,000.

KDC will begin construction immediately and pursue LEED Silver certification on the approximately 165,000-square-foot, six-story building. The architect for the project is SmithGroupJJR and Rogers-O'Brien Construction Company, LTD will serve as the general contractor.
